LTD July 4th & Butte to Butte Service Announced

EUGENE, Ore. ---(June 23, 2023)--- Lane Transit District (LTD) will operate on its Sunday bus schedules on Independence Day, Tuesday, July 4, 2023. In addition, the Customer Service Center at Eugene Station will be open on Independence Day, July 4, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. LTD's Administrative Offices will be closed.

On July 4, LTD will operate a [shuttle service](#) for runners, walkers, and spectators participating in the annual Rexius OTC Butte To Butte so they can get to the starting line on the following schedule:

- Route [971X](#) will pick up passengers at the bus stop at 5th and Oak.
- Buses will depart every 5 to 10 minutes from 6:25 a.m. to 7:50 a.m.

Runners need to plan ahead of time and anticipate delays in service in order to reach the starting line before the start of the race. The free service is only from the pick-up location at 5th and Oak to Donald Street and 40th Avenue near the start of the race. Free fare applies to those attending the Butte to Butte.
