Who: ShelterCare provides housing and behavioral health services to individuals and families at risk of homelessness and those who are experiencing chronic homelessness. Our programs include Medical Recuperation, Short-Term Housing, Permanent Supported Housing, and Behavioral Health Services with the goal of moving program participants toward managing their own personal lease in the community.

What: Sponsored by Lane Forest Products and Kaiser Permanente Northwest, ShelterCare is hosting a cornhole tournament that is accessible to all ages and abilities. All proceeds from this event will go towards ShelterCare programs, which provide housing and behavioral health treatment to individuals and families who are currently unhoused, or who have a history of homelessness. All proceeds stay local to Eugene and Springfield!

This tournament will have a competitive bracket and a recreation bracket. Team costumes are always encouraged and there will be prizes for the winning teams of each bracket! Space in each bracket is limited and registration can be found on our website. Food and drinks will be available for purchase at the event.
