LTD Offers Free Rides to Cooling Centers

EUGENE, Ore. ---(August 11, 2023)--- With outdoor temperatures expected to reach near 100 degrees or more over the weekend and into next week, <u>Lane Transit District</u> will offer community members a free bus ride to and from the closest stop to the nearest designated cooling center.

Passengers will need to inform the bus operator that they are going to a cooling center so they are not charged a fare. All other passengers will need to pay fares to travel to and from their desired destinations.

Passengers are encouraged to dress appropriately, carry a water bottle, and consider preventative measures for sun exposure, such as using sun block.

In addition, passengers are asked to check Lane County's web site for <u>cooling center</u> locations and hours of operation.
