FAST FACTS: THE STORY BEHIND THE OLD SPAGHETTI FACTORY

- ~Guss and Sally Dussin are the founders of The Old Spaghetti Factory restaurant concept.
- ~The first Old Spaghetti Factory was opened January 10, 1969, in Portland, Ore.
- ~Today there are 43 Old Spaghetti Factory restaurants in 13 different states throughout the country.
- ~Since 1981, the Dussin family has also operated two franchises in Japan.
- ~The Old Spaghetti Factory is headquartered in Portland and remains a family-owned and operated business.
- ~Since The Old Spaghetti Factory's opening, they have served:
 - ~ Sauces, soups, and salad dressings made from scratch daily.
 - ~ Over 12 billion feet of spaghetti which is enough to go to the moon and back four times.
 - ~ Over 23 million pounds of Mizithra cheese. The Old Spaghetti Factory is the largest importer of Greek Mizithra in the United States importing 250,000 pounds annually.
 - ~ Over 82 million loaves of freshly baked bread.
 - ~ Nearly two million hand-rolled meatballs.
 - ~ Over 206 million scoops of Spumoni ice cream.
